

PHYSICAL SECURITY

The term 'Physical Security' in this document refers to the security procedures in operation to ensure the safety of the children, students, staff, volunteers and visitors at the projects managed by the Father Ray Foundation.

Identity Cards

Identity cards are issued to all members of staff and volunteers and **MUST** be worn at all times.

Identity cards are issued in a variety of colours depending on the project the wearer is working.

Each identity card features the following information

- The name of the project the wearing is working at
- A recent photograph of the staff member or volunteer
- An individual staff number
- The name of the staff member or volunteer, in Thai
- The name of the staff member or volunteer, in English
- The position of the staff member or volunteer
- Expiry date, in Thai and English

Physical Security

Each project managed by the Father Ray Foundation will have designated security officers manning each entrance to each project.

The aim is to:

- Guide visitors to their intended destination
- Deter unwanted guests at each project
- Ensure theft of property is not occurring
